The past two years have been two of the most difficult and challenging turf growing seasons The Pines has ever encountered. With this good fall weather, our turf is beginning to recover but it needs more time for a full recovery.

What is most important now, is to enable our turf to continue recovery through the fall, winter and early spring to enable the best possible playing conditions in 2012. Therefore, when winter weather dictates, plans are in place to close, sand and cover the chipping green and playing greens on 8,10,11 and 12. In addition, we will use temporary tee boxes and greens in other locations as we have in the past.

We will work to keep the balance of the course open for play. While this is a challenge for winter play at The Pines, it is in the best interest of all club members for better playing conditions in 2012.

Many of you who have taken the opportunity to enjoy some of the great fall weather for golfing have noticed that we have done some tree trimming. This will help with air movement and irrigation in these areas and will hopefully stop us from losing trees when we have damaging winds and storms.

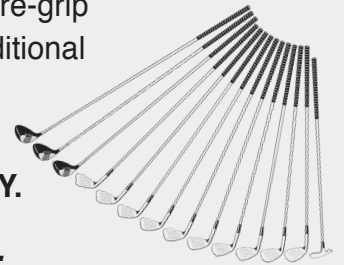
SHOT GUN STARTS
